HUMAN SERVICES PROGRAM



The Human Services program introduces students to the field of professional helping by offering a cluster of courses that are the foundation for further study. Students who are interested in social work, counseling, and addictions studies will learn from the carefully developed curriculum that is based on CSWE (Council on Social Work Education) standards. This will help students transfer into four-year social work programs. The curriculum gives both an overview of the helping field and an opportunity to experience it through an internship.

The A.A.S Human Services Program is a total of 65 credit hours that can be completed either on a part-time or full-time basis. Students who complete the Addiction Studies Certificate requirement qualify as candidates for the

CADC (Certified Alcohol and Drug Counselor) examination administered by IAODAPCA.

The curriculum transfers to the following four-year programs: Bachelor of Social Work at University of St. Francis and Governors State University, Bachelor of Human Services at National Louis University, Purdue University-Calumet Campus and Chicago State University also accepts students from the Human Service Program among other colleges and universities in college catalog (refer to pgs. 82-83.)

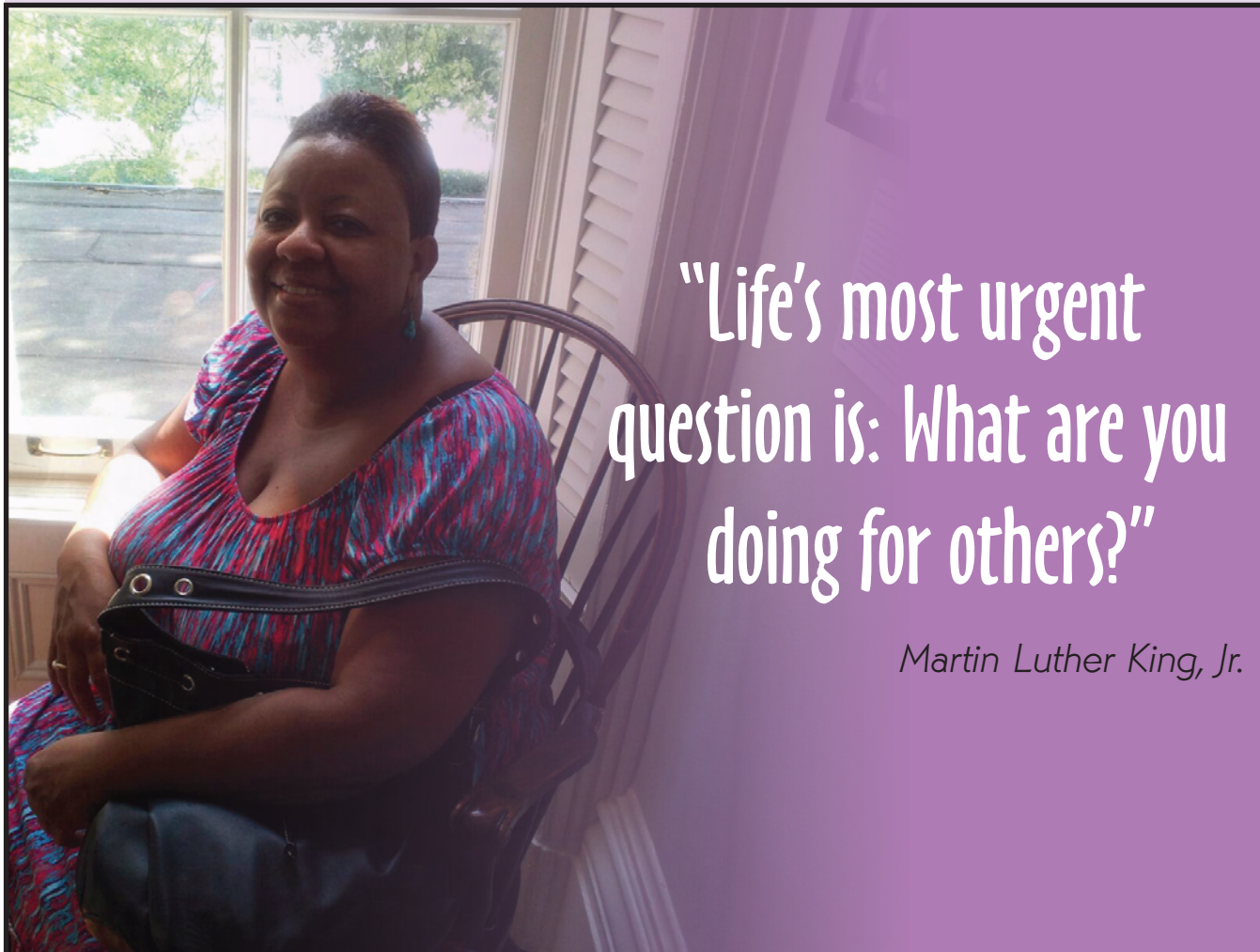
