Focusing on winter operations, this session will discuss preparation, policies and procedures, fostering excellence through staff development (including issues such as succession planning, dealing with generational differences), training including "the dirty dozen," doing more with less, new trends, and a preview/input for the Tuesday operator sessions.

All sessions will promote sustainability including effective snow and ice control with reduced environmental impacts that balance winter operations and the environment, equipment use, alternative chemicals, and the concept of doing more with less.
