BOARD OF TRUSTEES ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The South Suburban College Board of Trustees is offering two-year scholarships to outstanding graduating seniors residing or attending a high school within the boundaries of Community College District 510. Awards are based on academic achievement and will be granted to applicants who are in the top 15% of their graduating class or have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above on a 4.0 scale. These scholarships cover a maximum of 12 credit hours per semester.

Academic scholarship awards shall be valid for a two-year period beginning with the fall semester following your graduation from high school and continuing for four consecutive semesters. Awards will be applied to tuition costs (no fees, books, or supplies are covered) for the Fall and Spring semesters only, (summer semesters are not covered) and are renewable at the end of each year upon achieving a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or above.

The Board of Trustees Scholarship application deadline is June 30th.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST:

- Rank in the top 15% of your graduating high school class or have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above on a 4.0 scale.
- During your entire senior year reside or attend a high school within Community College District 510 and plan to attend South Suburban College as a full-time student (12 hours per semester).
- Complete this application and return it to SSC.

BOARD OF TRUSTEES ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

The Board of Trustees of South Suburban College is making available two-year scholarships to outstanding graduates who reside or attend a high school within South Suburban College District 510 during their entire senior year. These scholarships cover a maximum of 12 hours per semester (which is full-time enrollment). They cover Fall and Spring semesters only. Summer semesters are not covered.

Applicants must have graduated in the top 15% of their class or have a 3.5 GPA or above on a 4.0 scale and have the rank and address certified by the high school registrar or official. Candidates must also maintain a grade point average of 3.5 or above.

The Board of Trustees Scholarship application deadline is June 30th.

THE TYPICAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

- *Covers tuition costs for the fall and spring semesters up to a maximum of 12 hours per semester, which is full-time enrollment, during a two-year period beginning the fall semester following graduation and continuing for four consecutive semesters. (Does not cover fees, books or supplies.)*
- *Is subject to renewal at the end of each academic year upon achievement of a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 or above.*

ELIGIBILITY

- *Applicants must be a senior at any of the following high schools: Bremen, Hillcrest, Oak Forest, Thornton, Thornton Fractional North, Thornton Fractional South, Thornridge, Thornwood, Tinley Park, or reside in District 510 and attend another high school during their senior year.*
- *Completion of high school coursework.*
- *Ranking in the top 15% of high school graduating class or have a cumulative 3.5 GPA or above on a 4.0 scale.*
- *Resident of community college district 510 who intends to enroll at SSC as a full-time student.*
