B.A. in Early Childhood Education: Earn a Professional Educator License (PEL) for early childhood, self-contained general education (birth to 2nd grade) and earn an ESL/Bilingual endorsement.

B.A. in Infant-Toddler Studies: Earn your degree and up to three statewide credentials (ECE Level 5, Infant Toddler Care Level 5, Family Child Care Level 5 or Illinois Director Credential Level II). NEW: Early Intervention/Developmental Therapy.

B.A. in Applied Education Studies: Earn your degree and the Gateways to Opportunity Level 5 Family Specialist Credential (FSC), National Council on Family Relations' (NCFR), Certified Family Life Educator (CFLE). Credential Students choose from several majors depending upon their interest: Licensure, IT Studies, Family Services, Psychology.

Cost savings: Eligible Illinois early childhood professionals can apply for the Gateways to Opportunity Scholarship to cover up to 90% of tuition and fees (scholarship applications are processed and approved on a first come, first serve basis and dependent upon availability of funds).
