Exhibition of Artwork by Jewlya Sturtevant on Display in South Suburban College Dulgar Gallery

SOUTH HOLLAND, IL—The South Suburban College (SSC) Art & Design Department is presenting an exhibition of work by artist Jewlya Sturtevant entitled “How to Turn into a Frog” in the Lee E. Dulgar Gallery on the first floor of the Main Campus. Her work is available for viewing from March 13 through April 20, 2023. A closing reception will be held on April 20 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Jewlya Sturtevant is a Contemporary American Artist working in Northwest Indiana. She creates work known for its visceral and surrealist approach to depicting the figure.
